Procedure

Tune-in Activity (10 Mins)

- 1. Teacher will gather the children and sit in front of the teacher.
- 2. Teacher will greet the children with a good morning song and a "7 days a week" song.
- 3. Class rules are established with the children before the start of the lesson.
- 4. The class rules are as of follows:
 - Cross your legs and hands placed on the lap
 - Eyes on the teacher
 - Listening Ears
 - Raise your hands when you want to answer questions
 - Do not interrupt the teacher when she is talking.
- 5. Teacher will start the lesson by playing the "Old Macdonald had a farm" song.
 - "Let's listen to the song carefully and find out which farm animals appear."
- 6. Children will sing along with the teacher and follow the teacher's actions.
- After the song is played, teachers will ask the children which farm animals appeared in the song.
 - "Which farm animals did you hear from the song?"
 - "What sound did they make?"

Main Activity (15 Mins)

- 1. Teacher will introduce today's main activity.
 - "Today, we will be doing a fun activity where we will feed the farm animals."
 - "See the spoons on these number cards? These are the number of spoons you have to scoop for the animal."
- 2. Teacher will demonstrate how the activity is done.
- 3. Children will each get their turn to try the activity.
- 4. They will pick a number card randomly. Children will use the spoon to scoop the animal feed into the empty bowl/container. Children will scoop according to the number they see on the number card.

- 5. Children will count in sequence as they scoop the animal feed.
 - Teacher can initiate and guide the other children to count along with the child.

Closure (5 Mins)

- 1. Teacher will go through and recap what they have learnt.
 - "So children, what did we learn today?"
 - "We learnt about farm animals and we feed them today right!"
 - "We can now count to 10 and feed the animals food!"
- 2. Teacher will thank the children for the class.
